



GERMANY- A BUREAUCRATIC NIGHTMARE

Landed in Germany? WOW!!! It's an amazing feeling. Now breathe in all the fresh air you can. You will need it in the next few weeks.

1. Opening a Bank Account:

• Once you are done with your city registration, you can book an appointment to open a bank account in any bank of your choice (most popular being Sparkasse Aachen, Commerzbank, Deutsche Bank, N26, etc.). You'll need your City registration document, Passport and your Enrollment Certificate.

2. Activate Blocked Account:

- After you have opened your bank account, you can activate your Blocked Account by providing your IBAN number in your respective blocked account provider. It takes a few days to activate the blocked account and the money to be received in your bank account. You will then start to receive the monthly disbursements (usually in the last week of the previous month).
- Make sure to verify and carefully add your bank account details.

3. Activate Health Insurance:

• Activate your Health Insurance along with your Blocked Account (We recommend Barmer due to it's overall benefits & customer service)

4. Mark your Mailbox:

• Make sure your name is clearly mentioned on the Mailbox of your WG/Dorm because you'll now start receiving a lot of mails including your TAX ID, Social Security Number, Health Insurance activation details, etc. Also, do not discard any of these letters as you will need them in the long run.

ACCOMMODATION PROCESS (PART 1)


Finding housing in Aachen can be competitive, so start your search early. Here are some options to consider:

- Student Dorms: RWTH Aachen offers student dorms through the Studierendenwerk Aachen. These are affordable and a great way to meet other students, but there are a limited number of rooms. Apply as soon as possible. The waiting time is in between 6 - 12 months.
- We understand that a seamless onboarding experience sets the foundation for your success within this organisation. Our innovative onboarding process is designed to make you feel welcome, connected, and equipped to contribute from day one.
- Shared Apartments (WG): This is a common option for students in Germany. You can find rooms advertised online or through noticeboards at the university. Websites like WG-Gesucht can help with your search [WG gesucht Germany]. Be prepared to attend viewings and meet potential flatmates.
- Private Apartments: Studios or one-bedroom apartments are available but can be more expensive than other options. Search online platforms like ImmobilienScout24 or local listings in Aachen newspapers.

ACCOMMODATION PROCESS (PART 2)

Follow some of these important points:

- Write your message in German, use an online translator such as Google Translate or Deep L.
- Your introduction in the message should be polite and give out a basic picture of the type of person you are.
- Your name, degree, university, age, country, work-status, smoker/non-smoker, allergic to pets or not.
- A little bit about yourself and what your daily routine would look like.
- Whether you like to cook and your stand on cleanliness in the WG.
- Your hobbies and the languages you speak.
- The duration for which you would like to rent the apartment.
- Mention important details and cater your introduction to every ad individually.
- Remember : Quality over Quantity.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- City Registration: Within two weeks of arriving, register with the city of Aachen. You'll need your ID and proof of your address. - University Enrollment: If you haven't already, complete your enrollment at RWTH Aachen University. This might involve activating your university email and setting up your online student account. RWTH Aachen Getting Started: <u>https://help.itc.rwth-aachen.de/</u>







ESSENTIAL PROCESS

- Residence Permit: If you're staying longer than three months, apply for a residence permit extension at the Immigration Office. Keep in mind the expiration date of your current visa. - Health Insurance: Make sure you have valid health insurance for your stay in Germany. This is usually required for enrollment.
- **Broadcasting Fee:** Every household in Germany pays a monthly broadcasting fee. You might need to register for this, even if you're in a shared apartment.
- Bank Account: Sparkasse Aachen, Commerzbank, Deutsche Bank, N26, etc...







